SBAR Backgrounder and Assessment

Overview

The SBAR communication worksheet provides is a structured communication tool that can be used to bridge the communication gap(s) that may exist between professions, stakeholder groups and within teams The components include:

Situation = what is going on – identifying the problem

Background = identifying the context/history

Assessment = identify what the problem is

Recommendation = precise and specific recommendation of action

Item	Definition	Example
Situation	One sentence description of need.	Patient arrived for appointment on the wrong day.
Background	Details that give information to make an assessment. (Can be from patient's view and from your clinical view as you inquire and research).	 Patient arrived for 11 am appointment today. Appointment is at 11 am tomorrow. Patient comes from 40km away. Patient needed to have friend drive them to appointment. Doctor has 1+ appointment available on schedule. Doctor's hall partner has some open times. We don't know if the mistake was with the patient or the call center.
Assessment	Your position on the issue.	We should see the patient today.
Recommendation	Your specific method for solving the problem.	I recommend that we use the 1+ time or have your hall partner see this patient.
